RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRIES

Entries close Friday, May 11, 2012. ***PLEASE DO NOT FAX ENTRIES!*** Every Exhibitor, rider, driver, handler and trainer or his/her agent(s) must sign an entry blank. In the case of a rider, driver or handler under the age of 18, a parents or guardian must sign an entry blank on the minor's behalf. Post entries will be accepted with an additional fee of \$50.00. Stall fees must accompany entry to insure reservation. Each entry will pay the USEF fee of \$16.00 (Drugs and Medications fee \$8.00/ USEF Federation fee \$8.00), as well as the \$2.00 USHJA Zone Support Fee. Make checks payable to **Germantown Charity Horse Show, Inc. Mail entries to: Barney Mallace - 8411 Wood Manor Cv. Cordova, TN 38016.** There will be a \$50 returned check fee.

All Adds & Scratches must be made in the horse show office ***before*** the class starts. Scheduling difficulties at this show demand that you enter early and not attempt to add at the in-gate.

USEF/USHJA CREDENTIALS AND MEASUREMENT CARDS

All participants must present to the show secretary current USEF and USHJA membership cards or copies thereof. Amateur certification and measurement cards for Junior Hunters and Pony Hunters must be presented to the horse show secretary before numbers will be issued.

USHJA HORSE REGISTRATION

All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (exception: costume entries and leadline entries) must be properly registered with USHJA. Forms available with the horse show secretaries.

MEASUREMENT

Horses and ponies without a current valid measurement card issued by USEF will be measured by the horse show steward. Check with the horse show secretaries for a measurement schedule.

GROUNDS FEE

A grounds Fee of \$50.00 - for the week of the show - will be charged for each horse brought not in a stall.

NON-SHOWING HORSE FEE

A non-showing fee of \$135.00 will be charged for each horse, pony, mule, etc. stabled on the grounds and not in competition in ***a complete division***. Non-showing horses must pay the drug fee portion of the USEF fee and complete and sign an entry blank with the horse show secretaries.

EXHIBITOR PASSES

No more than 2 parking and 2 exhibitor passes provided per entered horse or pony. Additional passes will be available in the horse show office at a cost of \$5.00 per exhibitor pass and \$10 per parking pass.

COGGINS TEST

A Current negative Coggins Test certificate dated within one year must be included with entry. Health certificates with ALL ENTERED HORSES must be available as well.

STABLING

Permanent stabling of 262 stalls and additional tents are on the show grounds at a cost of \$150.00 per stall. All stalls are approx. 10x10 w/doors. **All stall fees must be paid before stall will be reserved.** Bagged shavings will be available through the show office and may be charged to your account. Stabling is available on a first-come, first-served basis. **EMAIL Barney Mallace at: Rowdy721@comcast.net for all stall reservations.** Management reserves the right to close entries. Additional stalls are also available during the show at the Shelby Show Place Arena.

STALL RESERVATIONS

Stabling will be available from 12:00 noon on Sunday, June 3, 2012
until 12:00 noon on Sunday, June 10, 2012.

REFUND POLICY: Entry fees will be refunded only upon presentation of a vet certificate before June 9th. After an entry is accepted, stall fees will be charged even if a horse is scratched. There will be a scratch fee equal to the office fee for any entry withdrawn/scratched after the entry has been accepted.

HORSE SHOW OFFICE

The Horse Show Office will be open by 10:00 a.m. the day prior to the start of the show for processing entries. The office will open 1 hour prior to the start of the show each day. No numbers will be issued without an open check or credit card filed with the show secretaries. No Exceptions.

RV PARKING

RV Parking is available at a rate of \$250.00 for the entire show or any portion of the show. Space is limited. RV spots must be reserved **BY EMAIL WITH BARNEY MALLACE at: Rowdy721@comcast.net**. RV Registration card must be picked up in show office and displayed in a location visible from outside the trailer.

SCHOOLING AND WARM-UP

For the convenience of exhibitors schooling will be allowed throughout the day on Monday, beginning at 10:00 A.M. All horses will be required to pay a \$20.00 schooling fee. Approved hard hats must be worn with chin-straps fastened. No poling or offset oxers will be allowed at any time.

CLASSES

The Management reserves the right to limit entries, alter courses; prohibit or disqualify exhibitors; change, cancel, limit or combine classes at its discretion to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries or due to acts of nature, without claim for damages.

OFFICIALS

The show committee reserves the right to substitute a show official in the event of failure of an advertised show official to attend this show or perform his duties.

PROPER ATTIRE

It is the tradition of the show ring that riders and drivers and handlers be correctly attired for all classes and that horses be properly presented. All riders in Hunter, Jumper and Hunter Seat Equitation sections must wear properly fitting, "approved" protective headgear while riding in the designated schooling and exercising areas, the show ring, and while mounted anywhere on the competition grounds. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until his headgear is properly in place. Formal attire is required in the Grand Prix. Proper attire will be required in all Classics.

FOOTING

All show and warm up rings are made of all weather footing of sand and limestone screenings.

MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT

Minors who do not have a valid driver’s license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver’s license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

HUNTER AND JUMPER CHAMPIONSHIPS

Hunter Championships & Jumper Championships will be awarded on the basis of points won in classes throughout the section.

TROPHIES, RIBBONS AND PRIZE MONEY

A trophy and ribbons 1st – 8th will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise specified. Prize money will be credited to exhibitor’s account and checks, if owed will be mailed within 30 days.

COURTESY CIRCLE

A dotted line may be put into effect at Management's discretion.

JUMP ORDER

A rotating jumping order will be established and posted for all jumper classes. All horses must be ridden in the posted order. Riders and trainers who have conflicts due to multiple entries in a class must see the starter so that necessary adjustments can be made.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

Open to all riders. Open to all horses not entered in the Grand Prix. Ponies may not compete. The same rider must compete in both phases. Cross-entry dependant on current USEF and USHJA Zone 4 rules. This class will not count toward any USEF National or Zone awards.

Part A. Classic Hunter Style Round

1. A minimum of ten (10) obstacles will be offered in the Classic Hunter Style Round.
2. Fences will be set at 3'3" to 3'6" in height.
3. Course to include at least one In & Out, one Bending Line and one fence with a long approach.
4. Jumps: Typical hunter-style jumps to be used in this round.
5. Points awarded for placings 1st – 12th as follows: 26-22-20-18-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-10.

Part B. Jumper Speed Round

1. The top twelve horses from the 1st round will be eligible to return for the Jumper Round.
2. This phase to be conducted under Table II.1 – fastest clear round.
3. A minimum of eight (8) obstacles will be offered in the Jumper Speed Round.
4. Fences will be set at 3'6" in height, spreads not to exceed 4'0".
5. Course to include at least 1 combination (double or triple) and 1 water obstacle ie: liverpool.
6. Jumps: Without a complete transformation of the original Hunter course, typical jumper-style fences with striped rails will be used.
7. Points awarded for placings 1st – 12th as follows: 26-22-20-18-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-10.

Overall Awards: The horse with the highest point total from both rounds will be the winner. Only ties for 1st place will be broken with a shortened jump-off course. All other ties will be decided on by the tied horses scores in the hunter round. The tied horse with the highest hunter round score will take the lead (for example: entry #s 227 and 301 are tied for 3rd place overall. Entry # 227 had a hunter round score of 80 and entry #301 had a hunter round score of 77 so #227 would end up 3rd overall and #301 would end up 4th). Overall placings will be 1st – 8th with prize money distributed as follows:

Each competitor will jump one round over a course of 12-15 jumps. After the first round, in the event of equality of faults for first place only, there will be one jump off in which time will decide the winner. The remaining competitors will be placed according to their faults only in the first round. In ties for other than first place, placings will be decided by time in the first round.

The order of GO will be drawn at Noon Saturday, June 11th. In the jump off, if any, all horses will go in original drawn order. Standing martingales are prohibited. Only running martingales used in the customary manner are permitted

Formal Attire Required. **No Exceptions Allowed.**

Biographical scripts of horses and riders are required before entry will be accepted.

Adult Amateur Hunter:

Adult Amateur Hunter classes are for amateurs 18 years of age or older showing horses and/or ponies. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, and suitability. The Adult Amateur Hunter section may be divided by age of rider and/or height of fences. Adult Amateur Hunters are to be shown over fences at either 3' or 3'3". Riders in this section may enter any Equitation class **and any class where otherwise eligible**. Riders who compete in the Amateur Owner Hunter and/or Jumper classes may show other horses that they own in the Adult Amateur Hunters. Horses and ponies exhibiting in this section may cross enter multiple sections of Adult Amateur Hunter and any classes where eligible. Note: The horse may only be shown by one rider in the Adult Amateur Hunter Classic and that rider must be declared prior to the first round of the Classic. Horses are not required to be jogged for soundness, but may be jogged at management's discretion. Zone Awards will be presented annually to the Adult Amateur Hunter 18-35 section and to the Adult Amateur Hunter 36 and over section. ***The Adult Amateur and Children's Hunter sections may be combined if there are less than three total in Children's Hunter section and if there are less than three total in the Adult Amateur section.***

Children's Hunter:

Children's Hunter classes are for exhibitors under the age of 18 showing horses. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, and suitability. The Children's Hunter section may be divided by age of rider **or** height of fences. ***The Children's Hunter section may be combined with the Children's Hunter Pony section when there are less than three entries in either section.*** Children's Hunters are to be shown over fences at either 3' or 3'3". Riders in this section may enter any Equitation class, but may not cross-enter into any Junior Hunter or Junior Jumper class at the same show. Horses and ponies exhibiting in this section may cross enter multiple sections of Children's Hunter and any classes where eligible. Note: The horse may only be shown by one rider in the Children's Hunter Classic and that rider must be declared prior to the first round of the Classic. Horses are not required to be jogged for soundness, but may be jogged at management's discretion. Zone Awards will be presented annually to the Children's Hunter 14 & Under section and to the Children's Hunter 15-17 section.

Children's Hunter Pony:

Children's Hunter Pony classes are for exhibitors under the age of 18 showing ponies. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, and suitability. Suitability (size) of pony to rider is of particular importance. The Small/Medium Children's Hunter Ponies are to show over fences at 2' and Large Children's Hunter Ponies are to show over fences at 2'6". The section may be divided at managements' discretion. The Children's Hunter section may be combined with the Children's Hunter Pony section when there are less than three entries in either section. Rider age restrictions as found in "Regular Pony" sections do not apply. Riders may show only one pony in either the 2' or the 2'6" height of the Children's Hunter Pony section when also competing in the "Regular" Small, Medium or Large Pony and/or Green Pony Hunter sections. Riders cannot cross enter into any class where fences exceed 3'3". Exception: Riders may show in Pony Jumpers. Ponies exhibiting in Children's Hunter Pony may cross enter into any class where otherwise eligible but the rider may not show the same pony in the regular pony section. Note: The pony may only be shown by one rider in the Children's Hunter Pony Classic and that rider must be declared prior to the first round of the Classic. Ponies are not required to be jogged for soundness, but may be jogged at management's discretion. Zone Awards will be presented annually to the Children's Hunter Pony Small/Medium section and to the Children's Hunter Pony Large section. ***The Children's Hunter Pony section may be combined with the Adult Amateur and Children's Hunter sections if there are less than 3 total in the Children's Hunter and Adult Amateur sections.***

Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper:

Open to horses and ponies. The rider is not eligible to compete in any jumper class above 1.15m (3'9") that offer prize money at the same show. Once a rider has competed in jumper classes over 1.15m (3'9") that offers prize money, the same rider cannot show in a Children/Adult Amateur Jumper class or classic offering \$500 or more for 30 days. Fences at 1.10m or 3'6" to 1.15m (3'9").

Low Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper:

Open to horses and ponies. Riders in Low Children's/Adult Amateur Jumper may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m (3'9") at the same show. Horse/rider combinations may cross enter into the Children's/Adult Amateur Jumpers at the same show. Horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both Low and High are offered. Fence height 1.00m (3'3").
